

2022 School Fee Changes

During Term 3 and Term 4, 2022, a focus for St Michael's was the preparation of the 2022 school budget. This work aimed to ensure we can continue to provide the best education for your child and protect the financial sustainability of the school.

Two main factors are influencing our 2022 school fees:


- a new government funding model which determines our school's fees are based on student needs and calculated on a Direct Measure of Income (DMI) score, and
- a review of the sibling discount for consistency across all Brisbane Catholic Education schools.

These factors have resulted in the following changes to our 2022 school fees:

- a **0.36%** increase in tuition
- an overall **0.99%** increase in school fees inclusive of levies
- 2022 sibling discounts will be as follows:
 - 1st child 100% tuition fee charged
 - 2nd child 45% tuition fee charged
 - 3rd child 35% tuition fee charged
 - 4th child 20% tuition fee charged
 - Additional children no tuition fee charge charged

I appreciate that an increase in fees can be difficult for some families. If you have any concerns about the 2022 school fees, please contact the school to discuss your family's circumstances.
